AMBULANCE SERVICE AND COMMUNICATIONS AGREEMENT

SUBSIDY ADDENDUM

THIS ADDENDUM to the Ambulance Service and Communications Agreement dated the 26th day of September 2023 by and between ARENAC County ("County") and MOBILE MEDICAL RESPONSE INC. ("MMR") is written to establish subsidy amounts for calendar years 2026 and 2027

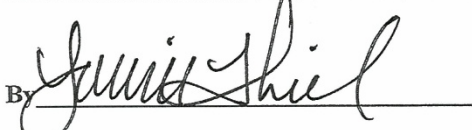
Section IIF of the Agreement states that the County and MMR shall agree to annual subsidy amount for January 1, 2026 and later by June 30 2025. A one-year subsidy addendum was agreed upon by MMR and County on June 24, 2025, for one year, ending June 30, 2026.

County and MMR agree that annual subsidies shall be divided into quarterly payments, which shall be paid by the County to MMR on or before the first of January April, July, and October in the following amounts: 2027: January \$285,894, April \$285,894 July \$245,894 October \$245,894.

The County and MMR agree to establish the service subsidy for the calendar year 2028 no later than June 30, 2027.
